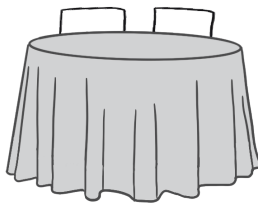


Head Table Configurations

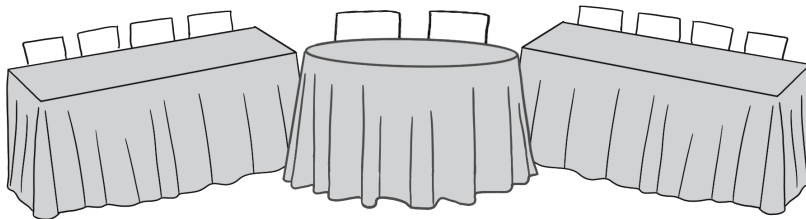
TRADITIONAL: 8' long rectangle tables end-to-end. Seats 4 per side/table. Can place one person at each end. Use one 90x156 cloth per table.



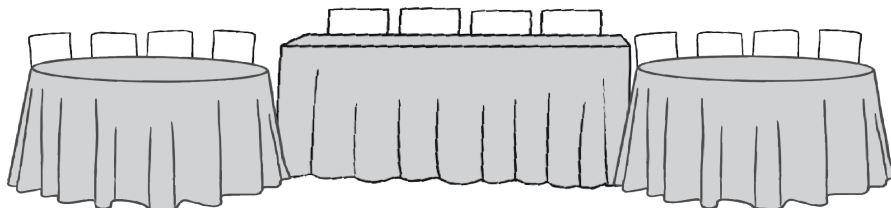
SWEETHEART: Bride and groom sit at 3' or 4' round table. Bridal party sits mixed with guests, or best man and maid of honor also sit with bride and groom.



SWEETHEART + HEAD TABLES:



TRADITIONAL + ROUNDS:



NO HEAD, NO SWEETHEART: Bride and groom sit with family or friends, wedding party does as well.
